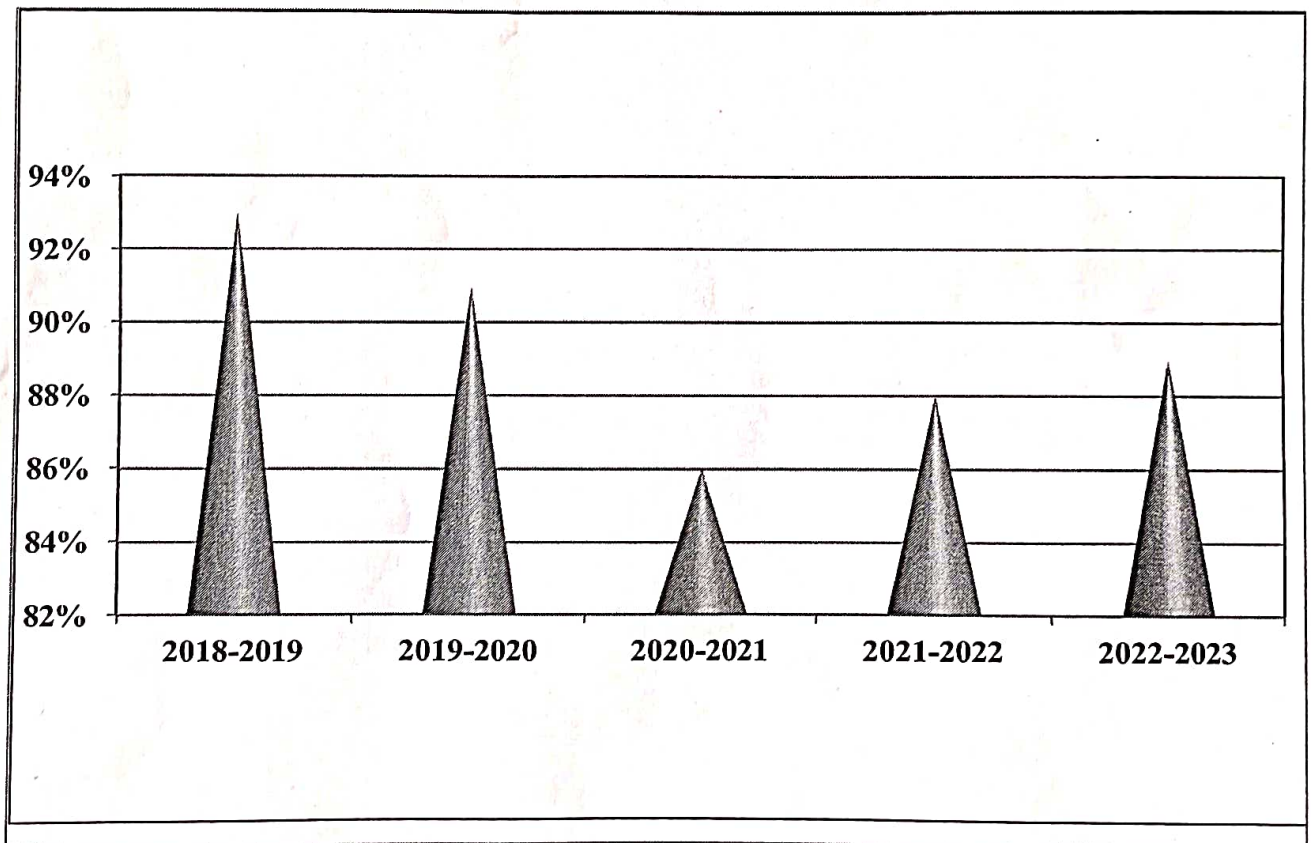

% Satisfaction Index versus Academic year**

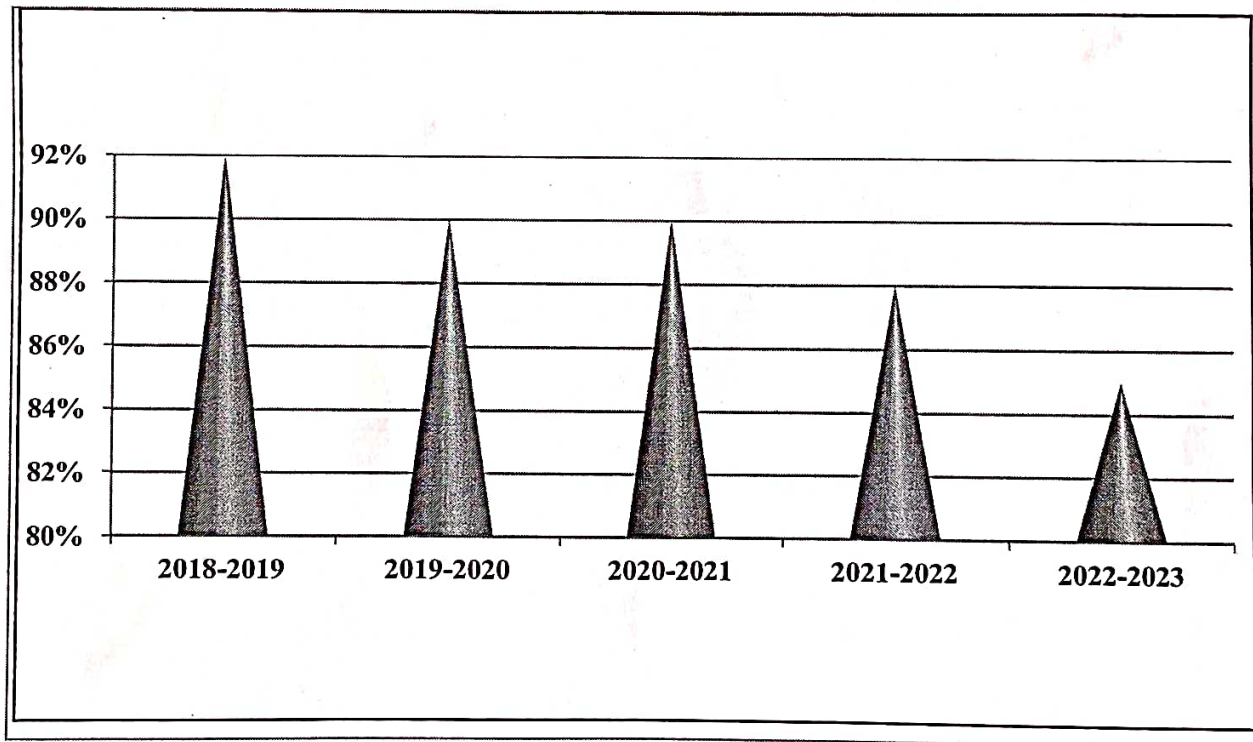

% Satisfaction Index versus Academic year**

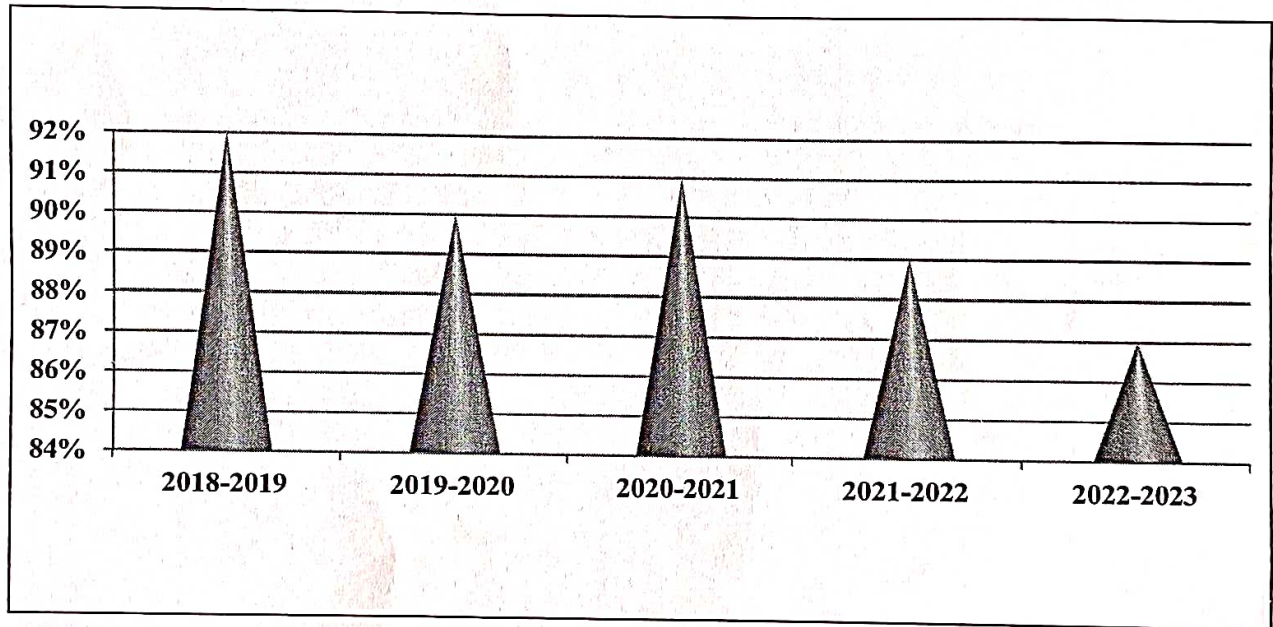
